From the Pastor:

"A Worship Resolution"

By the time you read this, Christmas will be past and perhaps all the decorations will even be put up (or perhaps not). You may have stayed up to ring in the new year or perhaps have simply gone to sleep at your normal time in 2024 and awakened in 2025. At any rate, we are quickly approaching 2025 and a new year. And as another new year begins, so also do New Year's resolutions, at least for many. New Year's resolutions can be good because they force us to take stock of our lives and challenge us by God's grace to improve in ways we see the need for improvement.

One resolution we can all make is to make sure we prioritize corporate worship. Even as his readers are facing persecution and the temptation to return to Judaism the writer of Hebrews exhorts them, "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." Corporate worship is intended to be a primary means the Lord uses to encourage us to live for him and face the week ahead. Not only do we sit under the read and preached Word and seek the Lord in prayer, we partake of the Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11:17-34). If you resolve anything for the new year, resolve to worship God. If you already make corporate worship a priority, then resolve to experience a greater blessing from it in the coming year and to bless others through it. We will be observing the Lord's Supper on Sunday, January 5th. Make plans to partake of the means of grace. And in an effort to prioritize worship and help you keep the Sabbath Day holy, we will be resuming evening worship. If you are able, double the corporate worship on the Lord's Day and double the blessing. There is no better resolution we can make for the new year than to prioritize worship.
