We will ask the Women's Ministry (formerly WIC) to assist us in planning some extra activities. As a Session, we will continue to serve our congregation. Any member will be available for any needs, questions, or suggestions.

As we go forward, we need to be in prayer for God to lead us in the search for our new minister, to help us to be diligent in our attendance and support of all church activities, and to take care of each other.

We pray for the Lord to lead Rev. Layton in his new chapter in the ministry and send our love and prayers to him, Ginny, D, Knox and Ben. We ask for you to be in prayer for them in the coming months.
